

THE RULES AND REGULATIONS IN THE DAILY ACTIVITIES OF YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS: EXPERT EVALUATION

According to the survey conducted by the author, among the main documents regulating the activities of youth organizations, all the leaders (26 persons) specified the statute of the organization and state legislative documents (laws of Ukraine, decrees of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, orders of the President of Ukraine). 8 associations amended the statute for the purpose of expansion and coverage of new areas and directions in youth work during their operation. 16 youth leaders said that when writing statutes organizations take into account the possibility of changes with the objective of combining and specified wide range of areas of work with youth and the population.

2 experts have not changed the purpose of the organization in statutes, but “attached the new objectives of the organization to the existing ones according to the extension of activities of association and emerging circumstances”.

Among other rules and regulations governing the conduct of members of youth associations and affecting the functioning of the organization, youth leaders called informal rules (corporate regulations, customs, traditions), which, in our view, can be noted in all youth organizations. The leaders of 12 organizations denied the existence of these corporate rules or norms, but confirmed the presence of traditions and customs.
